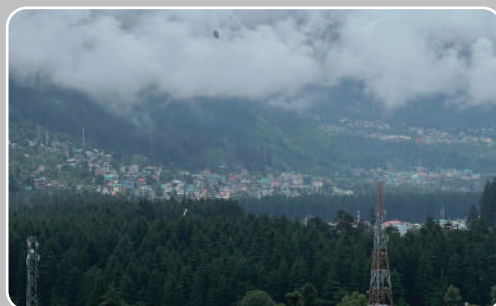

Would we need a permit to Visit any places?

Yes, you would need a permit to visit Sethan. Keego will take care of that. **The fee is included in your package cost.**

You pay a booking amount of INR 12,000 to book your spot. The remainder amount is payable 20 days before the departure date.

At what time and where are we supposed to assemble in Delhi on 27 September?

Everyone should reach Majnu ka Tilla between 8-9 Pm, Our Bus will depart from Delhi Max by 10:30 Pm. Any changes to the same shall be conveyed over the whatsapp group.

At what time will we reach Delhi on 2nd October?

The group will be departing from Manali between 6-8 PM on 2nd October. Everyone should be able to reach Majnu ka Tilla between 6-9 AM.

What meals will be provided during the trip?

3 Breakfasts and 3 Dinners (Starting from Day 1 Dinner, till Day 4 Breakfast). It will have both the options Veg and Non Veg. Also, one picnic lunch on Day 1 and Local Lunch on Day 3 is included.

Is there a group leader accompanying the journey?

Yes! Experienced people who have been to the location multiple times shall be accompanying you.
